


NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS
OF THE CITY OF GROVETOWN, COUNTY OF COLUMBIA, STATE OF GEORGIA

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 21-2-540 you are hereby notified that there will be a special election held by the Columbia County Board of Elections for the City of Grovetown, GA on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 for the purpose of filling the remaining portion of the unexpired term for the office of Councilmember of the Grovetown City Council vacated by the passing of Allen Transou. Qualifying will be conducted in the City Clerk's Office, 103 Old Wrightsboro Road, Grovetown, Georgia, beginning on Monday February 1, 2021, February 2, 2021, and ending on Wednesday February 3, 2021. Hours to qualify for said office shall be from 9:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on Monday February 1, Tuesday February 2, 2021 and Wednesday February 3, 2021. A qualifying fee of \$150.00, as prescribed by law, will be required upon qualifying for office. Only those persons who have filed their Notice of Candidacy and have paid the prescribed qualifying fee as stated above shall be eligible to have their names placed on the ballot. Said election will be for the remainder of said unexpired term for Councilmember Transou, which will expire on December 31, 2023.

Anyone desiring to vote in this election and who is not a qualified voter must register to vote no later than Tuesday, February 16, 2020, at any of the approved voter registration sites in order to be eligible to vote. The polling places for holding this special election shall be the regular and established polling locations for the City of Grovetown, GA, and the polls shall be open from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM.
